

Pretty straightforward puzzle; the band names are all the opposites of existing band names (i.e. Stationary Boulders = Rolling Stones) and the song names are all the opposites of popular songs by those bands (i.e. Remain on my Visible Mass of Droplets = Get Off of My Cloud).

By taking the letter associated with the bands in the order they appear in the list, interleaved with the letter of the song those bands go to (i.e. L from first band, A from song first band goes with, S from second band, T from song second band goes with), you get LAST NAME OF SEVENTH US PRESIDENT, giving you the answer of JACKSON.
